Periodic evaluation:

There would be four examinations conducted in a year, apart from the promotion exam, i.e., pre midterm, midterm and post midterm. The syllabi would be out of the cumulatively covered portions. Out of the three, the average of the best two would be taken for final marks submission.

Subject Enrichment Activities (5 marks) :

These are subject specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. These activities are to be recorded internally by respective subject teachers.

For Languages:

Activities conducted for subject enrichment in languages should aim at equipping the learner to develop effective speaking and listening skills.

For Mathematics :

The listed laboratory activities and projects as given in the prescribed publication of CBSE / NCERT may be followed.

For Science :

The listed practical works/ activities may be carried out as prescribed by the CBSE in the curriculum.

For Social Science :

Map and project work may be undertaken as prescribed by the CBSE in the curriculum.

Co - Scholastic Activities :

Schools should promote co curricular activities for the holistic development of the student. These activities will be graded on a 5 - point grading scale (A to E) and will have no descriptive indicators. No upscaling of grades will be done.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL

DRESS CODE

1. Students should always be dressed in the prescribed school uniform or special uniform, wherever required. Clothes and shoes of the regular pattern will not be allowed.
2. All boys must have regular haircut (beard, sideburns and long hair on the nape, mushroom cut or crew cut are forbidden).
3. All parents will make adequate provisions for extra sets of school uniform and special uniform.
4. Informal dress (colour dress) is permitted only on the child's birthday. Children who wish to wear informal clothes on their birthday should avoid wearing jeans, T-Shirts, or tight fitting clothes.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

5. All students should, at all times, maintain a high standard of demeanour, in particular.
 - a) They should greet all ladies, teachers, administrative staff and visitors.
 - b) They should never keep their hands in their pockets while speaking to the teachers,
6. Students must attend the morning assembly without fail. Those who come late to the school will not be allowed to enter the class without the permission of the Principal.
7. Home assignments must be done neatly and regularly and submitted on the due date.
8. Money need not be sent to School unless a written request is made by the concerned teacher. If a child is seen in possession of any money, serious action will be taken against the child.
9. Even in the case of purchasing books or note books from the school stores, the parent will have to enter those details in the diary and the stores in-charge will be able to give books and notebooks on payment, only along with a written request from the parent in the diary.
10. Kindly bear with the school, if there is any inconvenience in the interest of your own ward, during rehearsals, functions and other programmes of the School.
11. The school is not responsible for goods lost by the students. It is the responsibility of every student to take due care of his/her personal belongings.
12. Classrooms must be kept tidy.

13. All waste paper and waste material must be put in the proper receptacle.
14. Any breakage or damage to school property must be reported immediately to the class teacher and the school office. The charge debited to the student will depend on the circumstances and nature of the damage and on the promptness with which it is reported.
15. No video and audio tapes, mobile or cell phones, digital cameras, CD & DVD Players, MP3, CD, VCD, DVD and electronic articles/equipment should be brought to school.

ATTENDANCE

16. No leave will normally be granted during term time.
17. No student should leave the school premises during the school hours without the written permission of the Principal.
18. Except for duly approved reasons, the extension of vacation is not permitted. Late comers after vacations, who have not been granted leave of absence, may have their names struck off from the rolls.
19. Application for medical leave should always be accompanied by a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
20. All leave applications should bear the signature of parents or in their absence, of guardians, who are directly responsible for the child.
21. Attendance on the first and last working days of every term is must.
22. Attendance not only to the sessions of school but also to all its activities is compulsory. Deviation in any manner in this regard will be viewed seriously. This includes Saturday work and other school programmes.

PAYMENT OF FEES

23. Tuition and other fees will be accepted only during the office hours between 8.30 am and 5.30pm. Payments once made to school will under no circumstance be refunded.
24. All Regular students of the school should pay the first installment of the fees for the subsequent year on or before the 10th MAY of an academic year.

25. The second installment of all fees and payment for transport shall be paid on or before 10th SEPTEMBER of the year by all students.
26. The third installment of all fees and payment for transport shall be paid on or before 10th JANUARY of the academic year by all students.
27. It will be the responsibility of every parent, to pay the fees for the term and seek the necessary details from the school,

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

28. Transport facilities would be offered to students who require. Transport charges may vary based on the distance.
 - a) Transport fees are payable term wise along with the term fees.
 - b) For further details parents may approach the school office.

CO-OPERATION FROM PARENTS

29. Parents should check the school diary and make due endorsements, making use of its various provisions regularly.
30. Changes in the address of parents or guardians must be intimated to the school and necessary changes are to be made in the diary.
31. Parents are requested not to disturb their wards and the teacher during the class hours. They are requested to be seated in the waiting area when they come to meet the staff members.
32. Parent attendance for the invited functions will be appreciated in the interest of their own wards.
33. It will be the responsibility of parents to get to know from their wards the instruction and circulars being issued from time to time and make due acknowledgements in the diary.
34. Participation in sports and games and in all other activities is compulsory on the part of every child.
35. Parents who wish to meet the Principal should request prior permission and fill in the required details in the form available at the school office.
36. Meeting the teachers / Principal would be possible between 3.30 pm and 4.30 pm between Monday and Friday.

SCHOOL DIARY

37. Every child should possess the school diary. The diary should be brought to the class every day. This diary shall be submitted to the concerned teachers for inspection. If it is lost a new one should be purchased.
38. If the progress card is lost a duplicate will have to be obtained on paying the penalty of Rs.100/-
39. No student or parent can arrange felicitation or offer any gift to the members of the school staff.
40. Parents are requested to ensure that children maintain the diary, text-books and note-books in a neat and tidy manner all through the year. They are not to be seen in tatters, with edges getting, folded.

IDENTITY CARD

41. Children should always be seen with identity card right from the time they leave home till the time they reach home.
42. If for some reason or the other the I.D. card is lost or damaged, a new I.D. card must be obtained immediately paying for it.
43. Children without ID card will be turned back home at the Bus stage/Main gate. Parents will have to bring such children to the school on their own, with the ID card.

INSPECTION

44. Classroom inspection will be done periodically. General hygiene, notebooks, textbooks, haircut and nail cut and will be checked.
45. Parents are requested to check the diary daily for home assignments, late attendance record, teacher's note to parents etc and initial them.

OPEN DAYS (Parent Teacher meetings)

46. Open Day is a very important programme of the School. These open days provide an opportunity for the parents to interact with the teachers, to get to know the progress of their child in academic and other pursuit in the School. Therefore all parents are expected to attend the Open day without fail.
47. Children's progress will be discussed during these Open Days. Parents will have to ensure that their wards do equally well in co-scholastic areas also, since the CBSE has in particular formalized these co-scholastic evaluations also.

48. If any parent has not attended all the Open Days for both the First and second terms in a year, the results of that particular student will be with held.
49. If the Parents, due to some unforeseen reason are not able to come to School for any Open Day in the date mentioned, they may come to School on any of the following three working days at 3.30pm and meet the class teacher after obtaining the principal's concurrence.
50. No alterations or any correction in the Achievement Record will be valid unless it is endorsed by the principal.

ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

51. Transfer Certificate will not be issued to those who apply after 15th April unless they pay all the fees and other payments due for the first term of the subsequent academic year, no matter they may not continue their studies in the school. There is no provision for any deviation from this specific condition.
52. A clear notice of 60 days in advance is required in other cases for issue of transfer certificate. Application for transfer certificate will have to be made only in the prescribed application form available in the office after signing a special register being maintained for this purpose.

CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENT

53. The School follows the curriculum as laid down by Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. It has classes starting from 1-12. The School offers a number of extra and co-curricular exposures towards a holistic education.
54. For classes IX, X, XI and XII, the guidelines of CBSE will be followed. Parents will get to know these details separately from the school.
55. No student will be permitted to abstain from writing a test or an examination. There is no provision for re-rest or re-examination. Only in the case of medical or unforeseen domestic developments an appeal can be made to the Principal for leave of absence.
56. If a student's diligence and progress in studies are continuously unsatisfactory or whose behavior is not commendable or whose parents or guardians do not co-operate with the school, he/she is liable to be relieved of the school rolls.
57. Grading System will be followed for all the evaluations. The range of marks for each of the grades will be shown in the Achievement Record.

ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWALS

58. A child must be three year old on 30th June of the school year before he/she can be admitted to the Lower K.G. No child who has not completed 5years will be considered for admission to class1. A Corresponding scale of age is fixed for the successive classes.

Criteria for Admission (Suggested by CBSE)

- ◆ Pre-Nursery: 2-3 years (born between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021)
- ◆ Nursery: 3-4 years (born between 1 April 2019 and 31 March 2020)
- ◆ KG: 4 - 5 years (born between 1 April 2018 and 31 march 2019)
- ◆ Class 1 : 5 - 6 years (born between 1 April 2017 and 31 march 2018)
- ◆ Class 2 : 6 - 7 years (born between 1 April 2016 and 31 march 2017)
- ◆ Class 3 : 7 - 8 years (born between 1 April 2015 and 31 march 2016)
- ◆ Class 4 : 8 - 9 years (born between 1 April 2014 and 31 march 2015)
- ◆ Class 5 : 9 - 10 years (born between 1 April 2013and 31 march 2014)
- ◆ Class 6 : 10 - 11 years (born between 1 April 2012 and 31 march 2013)
- ◆ Class 7 : 11 - 12 years (born between 1 April 2011 and 31 march 2012)
- ◆ Class 8 : 12 - 13 years (born between 1 April 2010 and 31 march 2011)
- ◆ Class 9 : 13 - 14 years (born between 1 April 2009 and 31 march 2010)
- ◆ Class 10: 14 - 15 years (born between 1 April 2008 and 31 march 2009)
- ◆ Class 11: 15 - 16 years (born between 1 April 2007 and 31 march 2008)
- ◆ Class 12: 16 - 17 years (born between 1 April 2006 and 31 march 2007)

CBSE Class 1 Admissions Age: 'CBSE Class I admissions age will be 5 years' Kendra Vidyalaya Sangathan had earlier announced that a child must be 6 years old (as of March 31) in the academic year 2022 -23 in which admission is sought for Class 1.

59. A pupil will be given an entrance test at the time of admission. The decision of the school authorities regarding the entrance tests will be final. A pupil who joins the school for the first time must produce a photo copy of the official birth Certificate enclosed with the admission form. A child coming from another school must produce a transfer certificate from the school last attended, duly counter signed by the education officer or the competent authority of the area.

60. A transfer certificate, or any other certificate, will be issued only if all school dues have been paid and library books and school items returned.

PROMOTION RULES

61. Students of classes I to VIII would normally be promoted to the next class unless their attendance of the year had been less than 80 percent and/or their progress during the year in the main subjects has not been satisfactory.
62. Those who are sick and are granted medical leave or those granted leave for exceptional reasons during assessment/examination may be considered for promotion if their progress throughout has been satisfactory and they have done well in the previous examinations.
63. Those absent for examinations without any valid reason(s) will not be awarded any mark/grade. They will not be placed on the merit list, either.
64. The child must have scored not less than grade C2 in each subject in all examinations, to be eligible for a promotion to the next higher class.
65. Children who score Grade E1 or E2 will have to repeat the same class for the next academic year.
